

Father Piotr Długołęcki (1958-2020)



Father Piotr Długołęcki was born in Piotrków Kujawski on 6 July 1958. He entered the novitiate in Taciszow on 5 September 1986 and made his temporary profession on 8 September 1987. Four years later, on 8 September 1991, he made his perpetual profession. His priestly ordination took place in Warsaw in the cathedral basilica on 28 May 1992.

Father Piotr began his ministry as the vicar of the St. Camillus Parish in Zabrze. Over the next few years he worked as the vicar of the parishes of Biała and Tarnowskie Góry and was a chaplain in Warsaw and Rome (at the St. Camillus Hospital).

In 2008 he was appointed the resident of the Camillian community of Lourdes (France). A year later after his work at Lourdes he returned to Poland. He worked as a chaplain at the St. Camillus Hospital of Tarnowskie Góry.

In remembering Father Piotr, there stands out his good, peaceful and sociable character. He demonstrated joy about his vocation in his words and his face.
