Becoming the Prophets

- Being prophets requires creativity and audacity,
- to open up and travel together along new roads that our fathers did not travel;
- to revise the structures that might have worked in the past, but which today no longer correspond to the new dynamism of the mission;
- to renew the style and models in which the charism of our Institutes was incarnated in the past.
- It is the "prophecy of evangelical choices" (Letter of the CIVCSVA, Scrutate, p. 85) to express also in new forms the potentialities of the charism, the "energies" enclosed in it and not yet fully deployed.

HOW? Strategic Directions

- Starting with an Internal Analysis using modern tools and resources to identify Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Challenges of our existing ministries.
- Creating **Technical Support Groups** (Core Areas) to prepare a working document on Strategic Plan for the Order.
- Using the synodal approach, engage all religious for feedback and practical suggestions at all levels, especially the young religious.

Strategic Directions...

- Using the Major Superiors Forum meeting with Consulta to discuss and prepare strategic document
- Finalizing the Road Map (Strategic Development Plan) for the short term and long term goals for the Order at regional and international levels
- **Operationalizing** the Plan at the Provincial and Delegation levels with guidance and support of the General Consulta.
- Establishing **Evaluation and Review** mechanisms integrating Monitoring and Evaluation Framework into the strategic plan.

Some specific areas for consideration

- Camillian Project and greater collaboration with Provinces and Delegations of the Order
- Collaboration with Greater Camillian Family (Eight Expressions of the Camillian Charism)
- "Mini" Camillianums regionally to promote pastoral formation in healthcare
- Formation for Mission and our Formation of the young religious
